About

The Florida Department of Transportation's contractor, Astaldi Construction Corporation, is widening approximately four miles of US Highway 301 from SR 674 (Sun City Center Boulevard) to Balm Road in Hillsborough County.

As part of this project, the contractor is making the following improvements:

- Widening the roadway to a six-lane divided rural road with a raised medians and paved shoulders
- Adding a five-foot sidewalk to the west side and a twelve-foot multi-use path to the east side of the roadway
- Constructing multiple ponds and adding a new drainage system

The contractors' work hours on the project are from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, with frequent Saturday work and occasional nighttime and Sunday work.

This project is expected to finish in late 2020.
