**About**

This design build project will build a new southbound/westbound interstate bridge over Old Tampa Bay between Hillsborough and Pinellas counties in West Central Florida.

The new bridge will be built north of the current southbound/westbound interstate bridge. It will consist of eight lanes; four general use lanes, two northbound/eastbound express lanes and two southbound/westbound express lanes and a bicycle/pedestrian path.

The existing southbound/westbound bridge will be converted to the new northbound/eastbound I-275. When complete, the current northbound/eastbound bridge will be removed.

Bid proposal are scheduled to be opened in the fall of 2019. Construction activities are anticipated to begin in 2020.
