



Median Modifications Project Notification Requirement

Any project on the State Highway System that will divide a state highway or erect median barriers modifying currently available vehicle turning movements or have the effect of closing or modifying an existing access to an abutting property owner, requires a public notification.



The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Seven is proposing to modify several medians along US 92 (4th St. N) from 30th Ave. N to 94th Ave. N. in Pinellas County, Florida.

This project includes extending left turn lane storage at nine signalized intersections and 15 left turn lanes at existing median openings along the corridor. Some existing median openings will be modified, lengthening the left turn lane storage, and others will be closed. Additionally, nine mid-block pedestrian crossings will be built.

The median closures and turn lane extensions will improve safety and traffic flow. The new crosswalks with pedestrian signals will allow pedestrians to cross US 92 (4th St. N) at designated locations more safely. U-turn locations are available throughout the corridor to access businesses.

The following slides show where the medians are proposed to be changed.



Access to 4th St.




- Locations where raised medians are being constructed allow for right turns only.
- U-turns are available at median openings and intersections.



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Raised medians will be constructed at designated locations throughout the corridor between 30th Ave N and 94th Ave N which will allow for right turns only. Left turns from the side streets will be eliminated where medians are being constructed or modified. All traffic movements currently being accomplished by making a left turn will be able to be accomplished after the proposed median modifications are complete by making a right and then a U-turn.


Motorists will need to turn right from the side street and make a U-turn at an open or directional median opening.



A raised median will be constructed at 31st Ave N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N).

This median modification is being implemented to lengthen the left turn lane from southbound 4^{th} St. to 30^{th} Avenue N.

Northbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N onto 31st Avenue N will need to make a U-turn at 32nd Ave. N.



A raised median will be constructed at $33^{\rm rd}$ Ave N to only allow right turns onto $4^{\rm th}$ St. N.

Southbound motorists who previously turned left from 4^{th} St N onto 33^{rd} Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 32^{nd} Ave. N.



A raised median will be constructed at 35th Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4th St. N.

This median modification is being implemented to lengthen the left turn lane from southbound 4th St. to 34th Avenue N. for additional vehicle storage.

Northbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. to 35th Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 37th Avenue N.

A new crosswalk with pedestrian crossing signals will be added north of 35th Ave N.



The median at 36th Avenue N. will be closed and will only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N).

Northbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. onto 36th Avenue N will need to make a U-turn at 37th Ave. N.

Southbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. onto 36th Avenue N will need to make a U-turn at 35th Ave. N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median north of 36th Ave. N.



The median at 37^{th} Avenue N and the Publix entrance will be modified to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4^{th} St. N.)

This median modification is being implemented to lengthen the left turn lane from northbound 4th St. to 38th Avenue N. for additional vehicle storage.

Southbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. onto 37th Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 35th Avenue N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added south of 37th Ave. N.



A raised median will be constructed at 39th Ave. N. to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N.) This modification is implemented to lengthen the left turn lane from southbound 4th St. to 38th Avenue N. for additional vehicle storage.

Northbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. onto 39th Ave. N will need to make a U-turn at 40th Ave. N.



The median at 41st Avenue N. will be modified to only allow only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N).

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added north of 42nd Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 42nd Ave N and 43rd Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4th St. N.


Southbound motorists that previously turned left from 4th St. onto 42nd Ave. N. will need to make a U-turn at 41st Ave N.

The left turn lane from northbound 4th St. to 43rd Ave N will be lengthened for additional vehicle storage.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median north of 42nd Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 45^{th} Ave N and 46^{th} Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.



The median at 47th Avenue N. will be closed to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N.).

Northbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. onto 47th Avenue N will need to make a U-turn at 48th Ave. N.


Southbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. onto 47th Avenue N will need to make a U-turn at 46th Ave. N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median north of 47th Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed 48^{th} Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added south of 48th Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 49^{th} Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.

Motorists traveling southbound who previously turned left onto 49th Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 48th Ave. N.



A raised median will be constructed at 51st Ave N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N).

The left turn lane from southbound 4th St. to 51st Ave N will be lengthened for additional vehicle storage.

Northbound motorists who previously turned left into Royal Palms on 4th St. will need to make a U-turn at 53rd Ave N.



The median at 52^{nd} Avenue N. will be closed to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N.).

Southbound motorists who previously turned left onto 52^{nd} Ave. N. will need to make a U-turn at 51^{st} Ave N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median.




The median at 53rd Ave. N. will be modified to only allow right turns onto 4th St N.

This modification is being implemented to lengthen the left turn lane from northbound 4th St. to 54th Avenue N.


Southbound motorists that previously turned left onto 53rd Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 51st Ave N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added north of 52nd Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at Barnard Blvd N and Palm Ave N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4^{th} St. N).


Northbound motorists who previously turned left onto Palm Ave will need to make a U-turn at Lincoln Circle.



A raised median will be constructed at SW and SE Monroe Circle N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.


Southbound motorists who previously made a left turn from 4th St. onto SE Monroe Circle will need to make a U-turn at Lincoln Circle N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median at Monroe Circle.




A raised median will be constructed at SW/SE Madison Circle N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.


A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added south of Madison Circle N.



A raised median will be constructed at SW/SE Jefferson Circle N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4^{th} St. N).



A raised median will be constructed at NW/NE Madison Circle N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4^{th} St. N).



A raised median will be constructed at NW/NE Monroe Circle N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4^{th} St. N).



A raised median will be constructed at NW/NE Lincoln Circle to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N).


Southbound motorists who previously made a left turn from 4th St. onto NE Lincoln Circle N will need to make a U-turn at NW Monroe Circle N

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median north of Lincoln Circle N.




A raised median will be constructed at Mystic Lake Dr N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to south of Mystic Lake Dr N.



A raised median will be constructed at Northmoor Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.


A portion of the landscaped median that is currently on 4th St. between Mystic Lake Dr N and Northmoor Ave N will be removed to lengthen the northbound left turn lane onto Northmoor Ave N and lengthen the southbound left turn lane onto Mystic Lake Dr.



A raised median will be constructed at 70th Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4th St. N.

Southbound motorists who previously turned left from 4^{th} St. to 70^{th} Ave N will need to make a U-turn at Mystic Lake Dr N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median south of 70^{th} Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 71^{st} Ave N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4^{th} St. N).



A raised median will be constructed at 72^{nd} Ave N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N).

Southbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St. N to the Siesta Inn will need to make a U-turn at 71st Ave. N.



73rd Avenue N & 74th Avenue N




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A raised median will be constructed at 73rd Ave N and 74th Ave N to only allow right turns onto US 92 (4th St. N).

Northbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. onto 74th Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 75th Ave N.

Southbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N onto 74th Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 73rd Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 75^{th} Ave N to only allow right turns onto southbound 4^{th} St.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median north of 75^{th} Ave N.




A raised median will be constructed at 76th Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4th St.

This modification is being implemented to lengthen the northbound left turn lane from 4th St. to 77th/78th Avenue N.


Northbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. to 76th Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 77th/78th Ave N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added to this median south of 76th Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 79th Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4th St. N.


A portion of the landscaped median that is currently on 4th St. between 79th Ave N. and 79th Terrace N will be removed to lengthen the southbound left turn lane onto 79th Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 80th Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4th St.

A portion of the landscaped median that is currently on 4^{th} St. between 79^{th} Terrace N and 80^{th} Ave N will be removed to lengthen the northbound left turn lane onto 80^{th} Ave N.

Southbound motorists who previously turned left from 4th St N. onto 80th Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 79th Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 81st Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.

A portion of the landscaped median that is currently on 4th St. between 79th Terrace and 80th Ave N. will be removed to lengthen the northbound left turn lane onto 80th Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 85^{th} Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. N.

A new pedestrian crosswalk with crossing signals will be added south of 85th Ave N.



A raised median will be constructed at 90th, 91st and 92nd Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4th St. N.

Northbound motorists who previously turned left onto 90th Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 91st Ave N.

Southbound motorists who previously turned left onto 91st Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 89th Ave N.

Northbound motorists who previously turned left onto 92nd Ave N will need to make a U-turn at 93rd Ave N.

The landscaped median between 90th Ave N and 91st Ave N will be removed to lengthen the left turn lane onto 91st Ave N



A raised median will be constructed at 93^{rd} Ave N to only allow right turns onto 4^{th} St. Left turn lane storage will be extended at northbound 94^{th} Ave N.

This modification is being implemented to lengthen the left turn lane from northbound 4th St. to 94th Avenue N.




