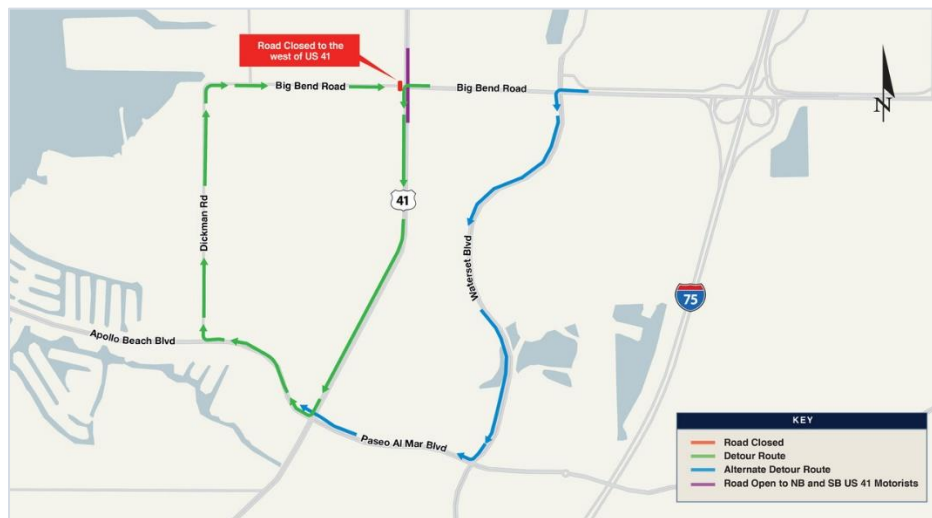

Big Bend Road Closing West of US 41 (Tamiami Trail) Friday Night

Gibsonton, FL – Beginning at 9 p.m. Friday, November 3, Big Bend Road will close to the west of US 41 (Tamiami Trail) in Hillsborough County.

During this closure, motorists will have to detour around the work zone using US 41 (Tamiami Trail), Apollo Beach Boulevard, and Dickman Road to access Big Bend Road. All northbound and southbound US 41 (Tamiami Trail) travel lanes will remain open through this intersection.



This temporary closure is to reopen before 5 a.m. Monday, November 13, weather permitting.

Electronic message boards and detour signs will assist drivers traveling through the area. Motorists should allow extra travel time as traffic delays may occur on nearby roads during this closure. Access to emergency vehicles and businesses to be maintained.

This project is replacing the asphalt pavement with a durable concrete surface at US 41 (Tamiami Trail) and Big Bend Road (CR 672). In addition, this project is repaving US 41 between 15th Avenue and Bullfrog Creek, adding a sidewalk along the west side of US 41, and connecting existing sidewalks on the east side of US 41 from bus stops to nearby intersections. The \$25.6 million project scheduled is to finish by spring 2024.
