

About

This design-build project will replace the existing asphalt pavement with a concrete surface at the intersection of US 301 and Big Bend Road (CR 672) in Hillsborough County.

Additionally, travel lanes will be added along Big Bend Road (CR 672) from Simmons Loop to US 301.

Work requiring lane closures will occur from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. (westbound) and 10 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. (eastbound).

Access to driveways, sidewalks, and side streets will be maintained.

Please use caution when traveling through the work zone and remain alert for pedestrians and construction workers.

What is design-build? Design-build is a method of project delivery in which one entity - the design-build team - works under a single contract with the FDOT (or any owner) to fully design and construct a project. **The contract work covers from initial design through construction completion.** This contract type typically allows for faster construction of a project as design and construction can be on-going simultaneously.
