




## Good Neighbor Trail in Downtown Brooksville along SR 50A, US 41 and Main St. 437264-2-52-01

This project built a 12 foot-wide paved multi-use trail in Brooksville.

This segment of the Good Neighbor Trail was constructed from west of the intersection of SR 50 and SR 50A along SR 50A/Jefferson Street to and through Tom Varn Park, then along US 41/Broad Street to Main Street, and along Main Street to Russell Street.
