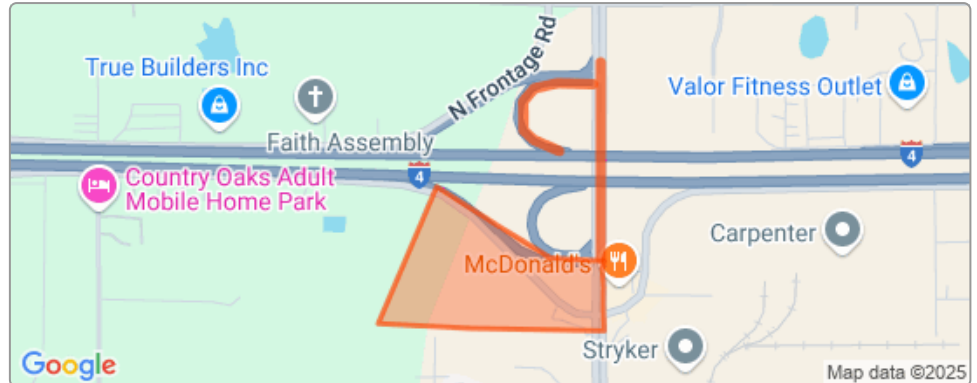

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About

The FDOT is constructing the new I-4 Truck Parking Facility, along with making roadway and pedestrian improvements to County Line Road over the interstate in Hillsborough County.

The new I-4 Truck Parking Facility is being built on a 49-acre FDOT-owned site and will provide 160 truck parking spaces.

The new facility will be integrated into Florida's Truck Parking Availability System (TPAS) to provide drivers with real-time parking availability information via a mobile application and dynamic roadside signs.

The project includes other infrastructure improvements for trucks accessing the I-4 Truck Parking Facility, as well as traffic entering and exiting I-4 at County Line Road.

Improvements include:

- Replacing the traffic signal and providing dual right and left turn lanes from the eastbound I-4 exit ramp onto County Line Road.
- Adding a traffic signal and providing dual right and left turn lanes from the westbound I-4 exit ramp onto County Line Road.
- Reducing the radii and adding truck aprons to accommodate trucks.
- Modifying traffic signals and reconfiguring travel lanes along County Line Road to reduce truck delays and improve mobility.
- Installing new signage and pavement markings, highway lighting, and ITS systems.
