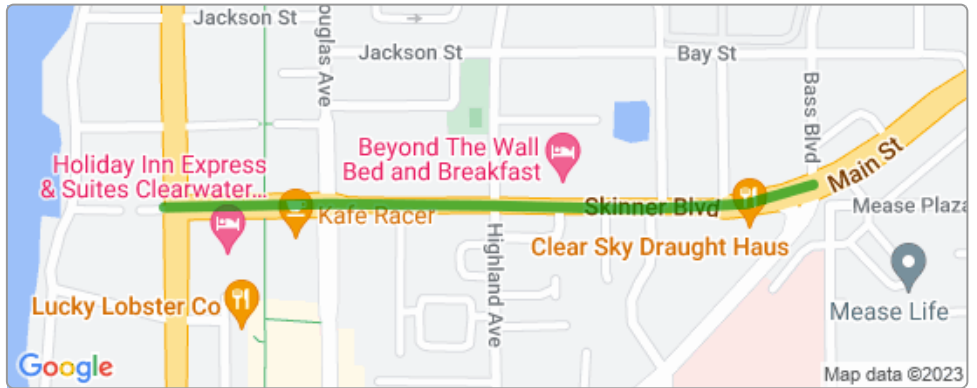

FDOT is committed to enhancing the safety and mobility of our residents and visitors with **Complete Streets** initiatives.

This **Complete Streets** project in Dunedin includes:

- Lane reduction from four to two lanes between Alt 19/ Broadway and Oak Street
- Roundabouts at Douglas Avenue and Highland Avenue
- 10-foot-wide concrete sidewalks connecting to the Pinellas Trail
- On-street parking/bus bays and bicycle lanes
- Adding a permanent pedestrian crossing signal at the Pinellas Trail
- New mast arm signal Bass Boulevard/Main Street
- Decorative street lighting
- Raised median (landscaping opportunity)

Construction is currently anticipated to begin in 2024.
