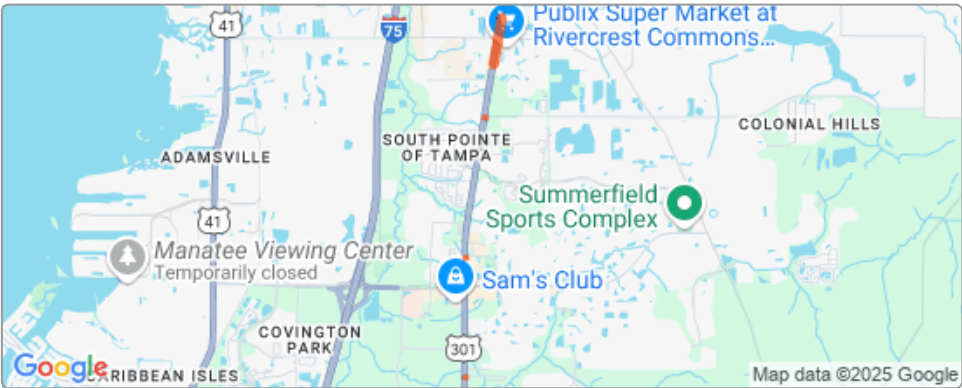


US 301 Intersection Improvements at Symmes Road 445392-1-52-01

About

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct the intersection of US 301 at Symmes Road in Hillsborough County.

The intersections will be constructed with rigid pavement to provide a sustainable surface with a longer service life.

The work also includes minor drainage improvements, bringing ADA features into conformance with current standards, and perform general safety modification work.

In addition, **traffic signals will also be installed to the intersections of US 301 and Shady Preserve Drive**, and Rhodine Road and Summerfield Boulevard/Ramble Creek Drive.

Construction is anticipated to begin during the early months of 2026.
