<<< New Traffic Pattern Coming to US 301 and Symmes Road >>>

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 301 at Symmes Road in Hillsborough County.

The intersections will be constructed with rigid pavement to provide a sustainable surface with a longer service life.

The work also includes drainage improvements and updating sidewalk ramps to ADA standards.

In addition, new **traffic signals will be installed at the intersections of US 301 and Shady Preserve Drive,** Rhodine Road, and Summerfield Boulevard/Ramble Creek Drive.

Construction activities are taking place during daytime and nighttime hours. Work requiring lane closures will occur nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Access to driveways, sidewalks, and side streets to be maintained. Motorists are reminded to use caution when traveling through the work zone and remain alert for pedestrians and construction workers.

Construction is estimated to finish during early 2027.
