Open House Tuesday, November 14 for US 301 Widening Project



Sun City Center, FL - The Florida Department of Transportation will hold a construction open house on the widening of US 301 from SR 674 (Sun City Center Boulevard) to south of Balm Road in Hillsborough County on Tuesday, November 14, 2017. The open house will be held from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the SouthShore Regional Library, located at 15816 Beth Shields Way, Ruskin, FL 33573.

The \$49 million project began October 30, 2017 and is expected to finish in late 2020.

There will be no formal presentation; property and business owners, interested persons, and organizations are invited to stop in anytime between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. to review the project display boards and plans and talk with project staff.
