I-275 Northbound Ramp from Floribraska Avenue Closing 45 Days

Tampa, FL – The northbound I-275 entrance ramp from Floribraska Avenue to close at 11 p.m. Sunday, September 11 for 45 days, weather permitting. This temporary ramp closure is necessary as crews build a new entrance ramp at this location.

Eastbound motorists traveling on Floribraska Avenue will detour around the work zone by continuing east on Floribraska Avenue, north onto Nebraska Avenue, and west onto Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard towards the northbound I-275 entrance ramp.

Westbound motorists traveling on Floribraska Avenue will detour around the work zone by turning north onto Florida Avenue, and east onto Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard towards the northbound I-275 entrance ramp.



Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Taliaferro Avenue will remain open to local traffic during this temporary ramp closure.

The \$85.3 million project is adding one lane in each direction to I-275 from north of I-4 to the north of Hillsborough Avenue (US 92) using the department's existing right-of-way. This project is expected to finish in early 2026.
