

## **US 19 Ramps to Gandy Boulevard Closing Thursday Night**

Pinellas Park, FL – Beginning Thursday, June 8 at 9 p.m. through 6 a.m. on Friday, June 9, the US 19 entrance ramps to Gandy Boulevard will close, weather permitting.

During this closure, northbound and southbound US 19 motorists needing to access Gandy Boulevard will travel around the workzone using 70<sup>th</sup> Avenue North and 34<sup>th</sup> Street North.



Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should expect delays and congestion during this detour.

This closure is necessary for crews to perform roadway lighting improvements as part of the US 19 interchange improvements at Gandy Boulevard in Pinellas County. Construction activities are expected to finish during the fall of 2023.
