Safety Enhancements and Pedestrian Improvements Coming to Kennedy Boulevard

Tampa, FL - Earlier this month, the Florida Department of Transportation began making safety enhancements and pedestrian improvements to Kennedy Boulevard (SR 60) from West Shore Boulevard to MacDill Avenue in Tampa.

Improvements include widening and repairing sections of sidewalks, upgrading highway lighting, adjusting traffic signal timings, closing some medians, and extending some turn lanes.

Currently, the City of Tampa's Water Department subcontractor is performing utility adjustment work throughout the project limits.

Construction activities are occurring during daytime and nighttime hours. Work requiring lane closures will occur at night between 9 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.

Access to businesses, residents, and emergency vehicles to be maintained. Motorists should use caution while traveling through the work zone and allow extra travel time as delays are likely.

This \$4.8 million project is to finish in early 2023.
