New Traffic Pattern: 4th Street N in St. Petersburg

St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning Monday, July 17, motorists should be on alert for a new traffic pattern on US 92 (4th Street N) from 5th Avenue N to 5th Avenue S in St. Petersburg. This temporary configuration will shift the southbound travel lanes to the west so crews can make modifications to the east side of US 92 (4th Street N).

Electronic message boards and signage will assist motorists traveling through the area. Access to businesses, residents, and emergency vehicles to be maintained.

This temporary traffic pattern is necessary for crews to perform work as part of the US 92 (4th Street N) Pedestrian Improvements from 5th Avenue N to 5th Avenue S project. The \$2.7 million project is constructing curb bulb-outs at 10 intersections to increase pedestrian safety. This project is to finish in early 2024.
