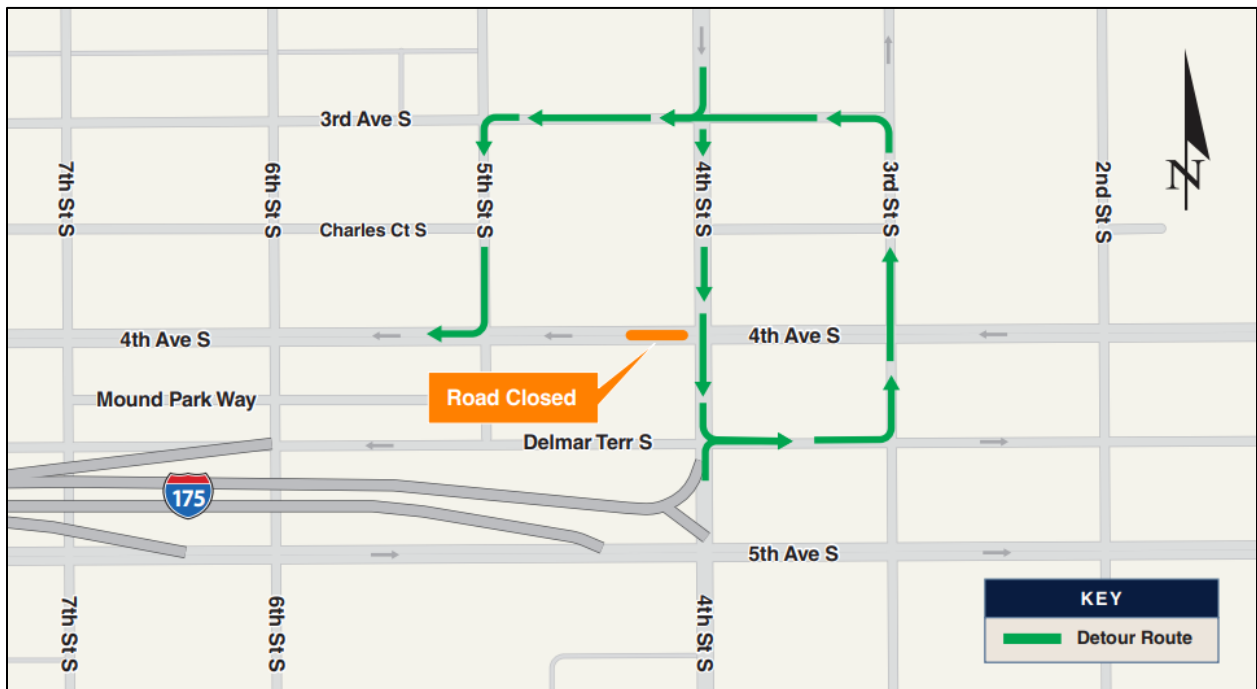

### 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue South to Close at US 92 (4<sup>th</sup> Street South)

St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning at 7 a.m. on Monday, January 9, 2023, 4th Avenue South will be closed just west of the intersection at US 92 (4<sup>th</sup> Street South). Southbound traffic on 4<sup>th</sup> Street South will not be affected. Motorists can detour around the work area by traveling westbound on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue South and then southbound on 5<sup>th</sup> Street South.

Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area.

The closure is anticipated to last two weeks so crews can perform necessary work to install new storm pipe and structures as part of the US 92 (4<sup>th</sup> Street South) Pedestrian Improvements from 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue North to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue South project. This project is expected to finish in early 2024.
