







If you are attending using GoToMeeting, on your computer or device screen, you should see a control panel that looks like this.



Any project on the State Highway System that will divide a state highway or erect median barriers modifying currently available vehicle turning movements or have the effect of closing or modifying an existing access to an abutting property owner, requires a public notification.







The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Seven is proposing to modify a median along SR 581/Bruce B Downs Blvd from south of Eagleston Blvd to SR 54 in Pasco County, Florida. The following slide explain the proposed changes.




The median on SR 581/Bruce B Downs Blvd, north of Eagleston Boulevard will be extended and become a raised concrete median.


Motorists traveling north on SR 581 will need to make a U-turn at SR 54 in order to access the Village Market Shopping Plaza.

Motorists travelling north on SR 581 Bruce B. Downs Blvd. can also access the Village Market Shopping Center by turning left at the new signal at Eagleston Blvd intersection.

Motorists traveling south on SR 581 will need to make a U-turn at Eagleston Boulevard in order to access Sun Trust Bank and Sonny's BBQ.






