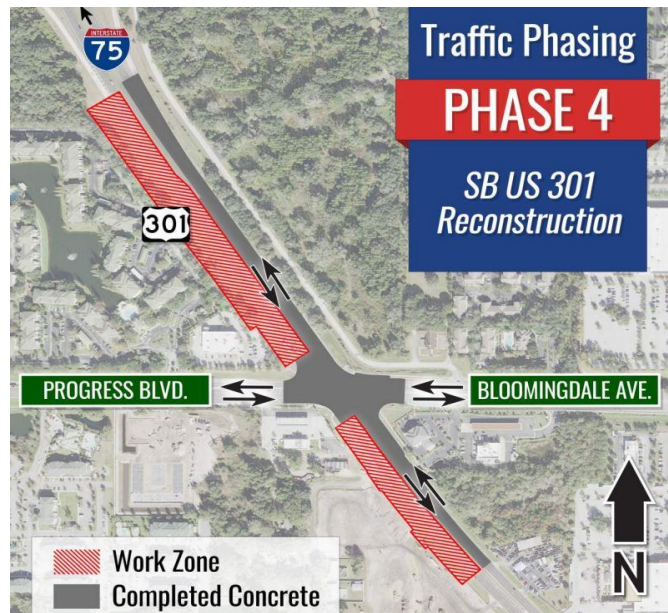

NOW OPEN: Progress Boulevard Travel Lanes at US 301

Riverview, FL – Progress Boulevard at US 301 is now open to traffic. Early this morning, crews reopened the new concrete travel lanes on Progress Boulevard to the west of US 301, allowing motorists to travel again through this Riverview intersection.

Over the next 21 days, motorists should continue to anticipate traffic delays and congestion while traveling through this intersection, as fewer northbound and southbound US 301 travel lanes remain under construction. **This intersection is being constructed in phases and is to finish in mid-April of 2022, weather permitting.**

Access to businesses, residents, and emergency vehicles continues to be maintained. Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards assist motorists traveling through this area.



The Florida Department of Transportation is replacing the asphalt pavement with a durable concrete surface at the intersection of US 301 and Progress Boulevard/Bloomingdale Avenue and repaving US 301 between Lake St. Charles Boulevard and Progress Boulevard/Bloomingdale Avenue in Hillsborough County.

In addition to repaving the roadway and intersection improvements, this project is adding a through-lane to westbound Bloomingdale Avenue at US 301, installing a sidewalk along the east side of US 301, and widening the US 301 entrance ramp to northbound I-75. This improvement project is to finish by early 2023.
