

US 301 north of Bloomingdale Ave/Progress Blvd Closing Nightly

Riverview, FL – All US 301 travel lanes north of the Bloomingdale Avenue/Progress Boulevard intersection will close nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Sunday, October 30, and Monday, October 31, weather permitting. These closures are necessary for crews to install new overhead sign structures over US 301.

<u>Northbound motorists</u> will detour around the work zone using Bloomingdale Avenue, Providence Road, S. Kings Avenue, John Moore Road, Bryan Road, and Lumsden Road.

<u>Southbound motorists</u> will detour around the work zone using Causeway Boulevard, US 41 (Tamiami Trail), Madison Avenue, Progress Boulevard, and Falkenburg Road.



Electronic message boards and detour signs will assist drivers traveling through this area. Motorists should allow extra travel time as traffic delays may occur on all nearby roads during this closure. Access to emergency vehicles, businesses, and residents to be maintained.

The \$21.3 million design-build project is making improvements to US 301 between Lake St. Charles Boulevard and Progress Boulevard/Bloomingdale Avenue in Hillsborough County. This project is to finish by early 2023.
