

Eastbound I-175 Exit Ramp to 6th Street South Closing Sunday Night

St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning at 9 p.m. Sunday, March 1 to 6 a.m. Monday, March 2, the eastbound I-175 exit ramp to 6th Street South will close, weather permitting.



During this temporary ramp closure, motorists will continue east on I-175, exit the interstate using the 4th Street South exit, turn left onto 4th Street South, turn left onto 4th Avenue South and proceed toward 6th Street South.

Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should expect delays and congestion during this detour.

This temporary closure is part of the I-175 concrete pavement repairs project from 16th Street South to 4th Street South in Pinellas County. Construction activities are expected to finish in early 2026.
