

I-175 Entrance Ramp from Dr MLK Street S Closing Nightly



St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning Tuesday, September 16 through Thursday, September 18, the westbound I-175 entrance ramp from Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Street South will close nightly from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. weather permitting.

During this closure, motorists traveling southbound on Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Street South will have to turn left onto 5th Avenue South, then turn left onto 6th Street South to access the westbound I-175 entrance ramp.

Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should expect delays and congestion during this detour.

This closure is part of the I-175 concrete pavement repairs project from 16th Street South to 4th Street South in Pinellas County. Construction activities are expected to finish during late 2025.
