Southbound I-275 Entrance Ramp from Westbound I-375 Closing Nightly

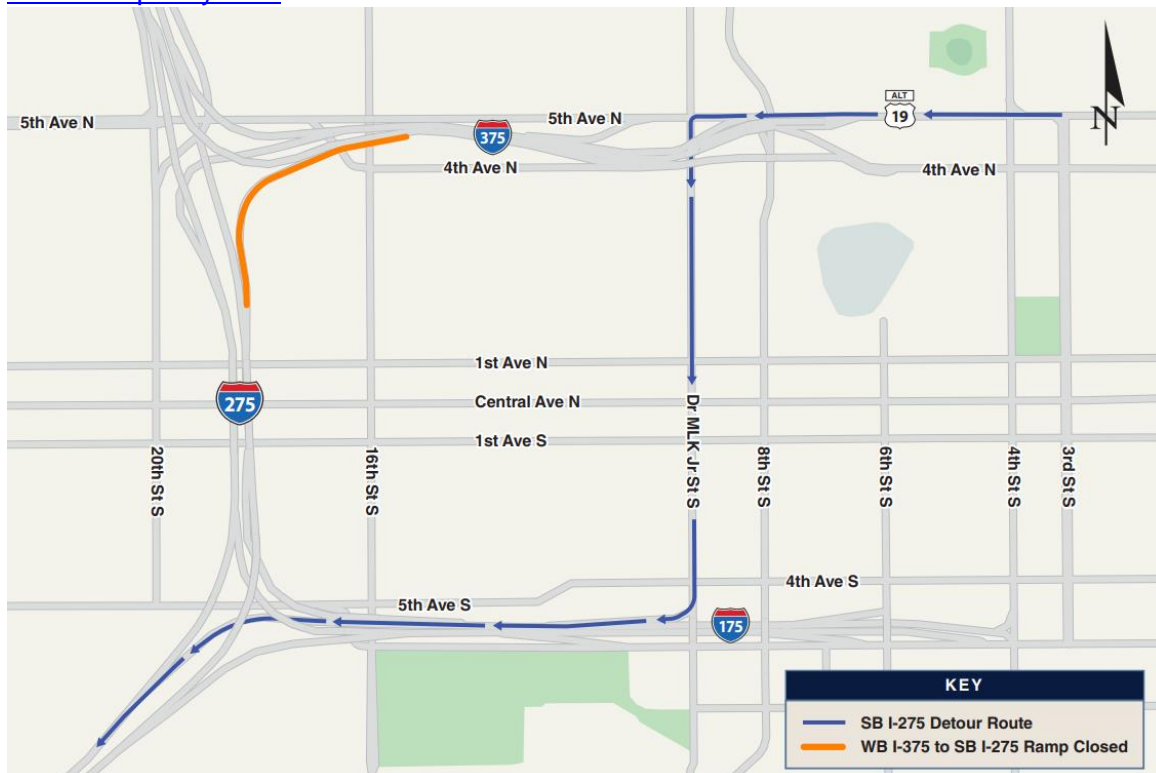
St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning Monday, August 19 and Tuesday, August 20, the southbound I-275 entrance ramp from westbound I-375 will close nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather permitting.

Motorists will have to detour around the work zone by travelling south on Martin Luther King Jr. Street South, merging onto the I-175 westbound entrance ramp to continue southbound on I-275.

Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should expect delays and congestion during this detour.

These temporary ramp closures are necessary as part of the I-375 concrete pavement repair project from I-275 to 4th Avenue North in Pinellas County. Construction activities are expected to finish in 2026.
