### **Northbound I-275 Entrance Ramp from 28th Street South** **Closing Wednesday Night**

St. Petersburg, FL – Beginning at 9 p.m., Wednesday, September 18, to 6 a.m. Thursday, September 19, the northbound I-275 entrance ramp from 28th Street South will close, weather permitting.

During this temporary nighttime ramp closure, motorists will continue north on 28<sup>th</sup> Street South, turn east onto 5th Avenue North, and enter the interstate using the northbound I-275 entrance ramp.

Advanced warning signs and electronic message boards will assist motorists traveling through the area. Motorists should expect delays and congestion during this detour.

This closure is part of the I-275 concrete pavement repair project from 54th Avenue South to 5th Avenue South in Pinellas County. Construction activities are expected to finish in early 2026.
