

Dear Elected Officials and Staff:

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Seven, invites you to attend and participate in a Drive-thru (In-person) and Virtual Public Meeting covering upcoming access changes to State Road (SR) 54 from west of Virginia City Drive to Old Mill Pond Drive in New Port Richey, Pasco County, Florida. The public meeting will be held on **Thursday, November 9, 2023, at 5 p.m.** and on **Tuesday, November 14, 2023, at 11 a.m.**

The project will resurface SR 54 from west of Virginia City Drive to Old Mill Pond Drive. The traffic signal at Rowan Road will be upgraded and the existing median opening east of Rowan Road will be closed.

To allow for maximum participation, the public meeting will be held in three formats including live online, at an in-person location, and by phone (in listen-only mode). The information presented will be identical at all options.

**In-person:** Attend the drive-thru in person on Thursday, November 9, 2023, anytime from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at **The Athenian Academy of Technology and the Arts, 3118 Seven Springs Boulevard, New Port Richey, FL 34655**. Drive-thru attendees will be directed into a clearly identified parking lot, receive project information, and view the project presentation on a tablet. You will have the opportunity for comments and questions for the project team.
