I-275 Widening project
from north of 38th Avenue N
to north of 4th Street N
Projects 449109-1-52-01 & 444243-1-52-01

Interchange Ramp **Closures** at 54th Avenue N

Two I-275 interchange ramps will be temporarily closed for an extended period:

- Southbound I-275 Exit 26 ramp to 54th Avenue N.
- Westbound 54th Avenue N entrance ramp onto southbound I-275.

Closing: Thursday night, April 9, 2026

Expected Reopening: summer/fall 2026

Detours: Alternate routes will be signed for drivers. Please see the maps and directions on the back. *Drivers are advised to plan some extra time to travel the detour routes.*

Questions and Answers

Why will the ramps be closed?

These ramps need to be reconstructed for the improvements being constructed to widen the I-275 corridor.

Can the ramps be opened sooner?

There is extensive work to be done to reconstruct this area before the ramps can be safely reopened. Contract incentives are being used to encourage the contractor to complete the work sooner.



Southbound I-275 Exit 26 ramp to 54th Avenue N

Detour map and directions



Continue south on I-275 past Exit 26 and exit at 38th Avenue N (Exit 25).

At the bottom of the ramp, turn right and go west on 38th Avenue N.

Turn right onto US 19 (34th Street N) and go north to 54th Avenue N.

Westbound 54th Avenue N entrance ramp onto southbound I-275

Detour map and directions

Continue west on 54th Avenue N past the entrance ramp.

Turn left at US 19 (34th Street N) and go south.

Turn left onto 38th Avenue N and go east to the entrance ramp onto southbound I-275.
