New Traffic Signal: US 301 at Stacy Road in Thonotosassa

Thonotosassa, FL – A new traffic signal, pedestrian crossings, and intersection lighting have been energized and are now operational at US 301 and Stacy Road in Hillsborough County.



Drivers should remain alert to the changed traffic conditions as motorists and pedestrians get used to the new signalized intersection.

Over the coming weeks, this project will finalize the installation of overhead flashing beacons at Harney Road and the addition of a new traffic signal at Mc Intosh Road. The \$2.47 million intersection safety improvement project is expected to finish during spring of 2025.
